The Honolulu Friends Meetinghouse serves as the center for many Quaker activities, and as the office of the Hawaii Area Program of the American Friends Service Committee.

In addition to providing worship opportunities, we are able to provide overnight sleeping facilities with breakfast for short stays of up to 14 days during any six month period to traveling Friends and to representatives of Quaker organizations; exceptions to be proposed in writing to the clerk of Oversight and Counsel Committee for consideration by the committee. (We regret that we are not able to accommodate special dietary needs.)

Accommodations are simple. There are three spaces:

A. Guest Room on main floor

- two single beds with nearby shared bath
- recommended contribution \$25 single occupancy, \$45 double occupancy

B. Book Nook behind the garage

- double bed plus futon with private bath
- recom .contrib. \$30 single occupancy, \$50 double occup.; \$70 three or four

C. Dormitory on lower level

- four single beds at end of First Day School room with shared bath
- recommended contrib..\$20 /person, single or double; \$55 for three or four

Parents of dependent children under age 5 may wish to contribute in their behalf. Guests are asked to make financial settlement the day before their departure. Friends Center accepts cash, checks, and travelers' checks. WE CANNOT ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS.

INFORMATION NEEDED FROM YOU

- Your Quaker Meeting or AFSC affiliation
- Time of arrival at Friends Center (Airline and flight number)
- Date of departure (checkout time: 11 AM)
- *Special arrangements are needed if you arrive before 7AM or after 10 PM

MEALS

- A simple breakfast is provided each morning. Kitchen privileges are not available, and guests are asked to not keep food in their sleeping quarters. There are many nearby restaurants.

TRANSPORTATION FROM AIRPORT

BUS

- Cost of bus \$2.25 exact change ASK FOR A TRANSFER
 - Take #19 or #20 (Waikiki bus) from airport to Ala Moana Center
 - Transfer to #6 (East-West/Woodlawn bus)
 - Get off at Armstrong and O'ahu
 - Walk half-block on O'ahu to Meetinghouse at #2426
- The last #6 bus leaves Ala Moana at 9:20 PM. Bus luggage space is limited to what you can hold on your lap or store at your feet.

TAXI

- Cost of taxi (about 10 miles) about \$35.00
- Tell driver O'ahu Ave. is one block from University Ave. and #2426 is near Armstrong Street (MANOA DISTRICT OF HONOLULU)

RENTAL CAR

- Cost is quite reasonable, but RESERVATIONS ARE ADVISABLE

-DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Follow signs to H1 EAST (toward Honolulu/Waikiki)
Exit H1 East at Punahou St. exit, #23. Turn left on Punahou St. and go 1.3 miles. Punahou turns into Manoa and stay right on East Manoa at the fork in the road. O'ahu Ave. is at the 5th stoplight from H1, (1.3 miles) turn right and again stay right at the fork in the road. We are the 5th house on the right hand side from the fork in the road 2426 O'ahu Ave." Sign is in the front yard.
